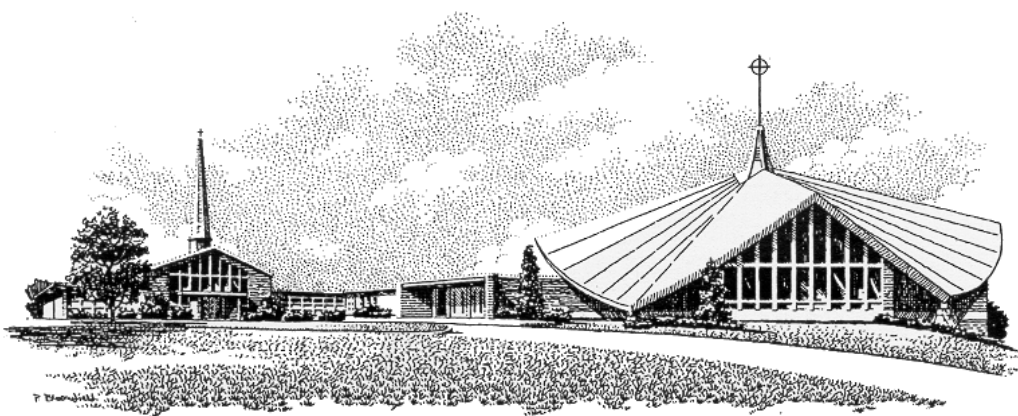

## The Rector

---

2009 was a difficult year around the world. Perhaps difficult times make God's grace even more evident: another year of grace.

We started out with an ice-storm that paralyzed our city. Parishioners reached out to care for each other, but we realized we must be better organized in such an event, and able to contact every parishioner, especially the most vulnerable. We now have a group of people working on emergency responses, strengthening the way we function as a community.

The world-wide recession meant that unemployment rose, affecting us all. Some parishioners lost jobs, or retired early, or moved to part-time work. Many more suffered anxiety. All of us have friends or family affected. Again, the good news was community in the Body of Christ here at St. Matthew's.

Despite a very tight budget, we grew and flourished and continued to reach out. Our Community Preschool opened in September, and has been incredibly successful. Working with Holy Trinity, we built another Habitat House. We brought back *Dimensions of Faith*, with Sara Miles, author of "Take This Bread", and her visit was perfectly timed to be the final encouragement we needed to commit to opening a Dare to Care food pantry here (in partnership with St. MAMs). We spent the fall beginning a parish-wide focus on hunger.

These were some of the "big" things, but it is the more everyday things that weave the fabric of community: Trivia Night. The pancake supper. The summer band concert. St. Matthew's Day. The visitors from our companion parish in Scotland. Our first marriage retreat. All the small groups that meet to pray, to study, to grow together. Building community, building up the Body of Christ.

(Speaking of building up, have you noticed how many new babies we have? The nursery is overflowing!)

And, of course, worship as the center of our life together. Sunday after Sunday, coming together to be fed so that we may feed others. Discovering our unity in Christ, a unity far more basic than any differences of age, gender, income, race, political persuasion, or whatever else we focus on in our divided world.

It was with real sorrow that we said goodbye to Jim Trimble in March, and I am very grateful to Moray Peoples for picking up so many pieces as an interim assistant. Emily Schwartz and Jerry Cappel were enthusiastically welcomed at the end of the year; they come with astonishing gifts for ministry. I am, more than ever, grateful for the creativity, hard work, and care of ALL our staff: Helen Jones, Debbi Rodahaffer, Barbara Ellis, Mardi Galvin, Ruth Kempf, Lynn Miller, Karen Hill, Ann Davis, David Reed, Brandon Brones, and Matt Averbeck, along with Emily, Jerry and Moray. The Preschool functions separately, but is an integral part of St. Matthew's, and Lauren Becker is amazing. **BUT:** do you know that of that long list only 4 (including me) are full-time? ALL of them put in many more hours than they are paid for, but you should realize that it is actually quite a small group that accomplishes so many amazing things here. I am grateful to God for them, and for all of you.

## Senior Warden

---

As I look back upon this past year, I am excited about our accomplishments and the potential for the upcoming year.

We have always been a caring, inclusive parish. Out of concern that some visitors might fall through the cracks, a new Welcoming Committee was formed. With the leadership and passion of Sarah Causey and Robin Garr, we now have a visitor's information desk that is staffed every Sunday. Greeters, in addition to welcoming newcomers and visitors can now direct them to the desk where they can find out more about us and to start establishing deeper connections that will make them feel more at home. With the help of the entire parish, we have many new members in our sanctuary. Also as a result of all our new members, Via Media has become much more popular.

The most difficult decision for the vestry during my tenure has been voting to support blessing for same sex committed relationships. I believe we successfully walked the thin line between making these couples feel truly included and not alienating any who did not agree with our decision. After struggling with the vote, it became a non-issue in the life of our church and community, except for those whose lives have been enriched by our recognition of their relationships.

In October we hosted Sara Miles, author of Take this Bread, who encouraged us with tales of the food bank she started at St. Gregory's. Thanks to a year of hard work by vestry member Brian Good, St. Matthew's will now be a distribution center for a Dare to Care Food Bank. Taking this one step further, Steve Hall is leading the effort to convert part of our land into a garden with the produce to be distributed along with the package food.

In the spring, we bid farewell to The Rev. Jim Trimble when he became rector at St. James, Pewee Valley. In December we welcomed The Rev. Emily Schwartz as Assistant Rector, and The Rev. Jerry Cappel as Associate for Justice Ministries. They are both gifted and committed individuals and we are fortunate to have them on our staff.

This fall, we opened the Community Preschool at St. Matthew's. Lauren Becker accepted the role of director for the preschool. While we miss her presence on the vestry, we can already see the fruits of her energy and creativity. It's hard to miss the preschool garden and all the toys under the downstairs coat racks.

Our Habitat for Humanity group was also successful with their sponsored home. After raising the roof in September, they were able to complete the house in time for James and Shannon Duke to celebrate Thanksgiving with their children in their new home.

I am sure that so much more has happened around the parish that I was not directly involved with. Thank you all for the love and service you provide both within and outside our parish. As always, I am pleased to call each of you family. Thank you for giving me the opportunity to serve as Senior Warden.
