◆ St. Matthew's Memorial Garden provides simple and dignified burial. The policies you will find in this brochure have been carefully developed so that the simplicity and beauty of the Memorial Garden will be maintained in the future. We ask you to read them carefully, and if you have any questions concerning them, please feel free to make your inquiries in the parish office.

- ◆ 1. No specific spot within the designated area will be assigned to the ashes of any person.
- ◆ 2. There are few restriction as to whose ashes may be buried in the garden. Please call the office for information.

- ◆ 3. The burial of ashes may take place when the family is present, if they so desire, or it may take place at an unspecified time. In either case, prayer will be offered.
- ◆ 4. St. Matthew's Episcopal Church, through its Aesthetics Committee, will exercise reasonable care in maintaining the area, and any plantings or enhancements must be approved by that committee.
- ◆ 5. There is no charge for the burial of ashes in this Memorial Garden though contributions may be made to St. Matthew's Endowment Fund for the upkeep of the Garden.
